

Supplemental Citation Guide

Submissions to *Interpreter: A Journal of Mormon Scripture* are peer-reviewed for content and copyedited for sentence clarity, punctuation, grammar, and citation issues. Authors are encouraged to refer to the *Interpreter Style Guide* before submitting their articles for review. However, formatting citations properly can be tricky even for those who have published extensively, and it is expected that minor modifications to the citations will need to be made in the final editing process by our copy editors. This can be done as long as all information necessary for the citation is included in the footnote. If pertinent information is missing, then the paper will need to be returned, slowing down the publication process. In addition to referring to the *Interpreter Style Guide*, authors may refer to [The Chicago Manual of Style Online](#) website for additional citation examples.

Below is a list of information needed for each type of source:

Books

- Full names of author(s), editor(s), or compiler(s) as listed on the title page
- Full title of book (**including subtitles**)
- Edition of book if there has been more than one edition
- Volume of book if part of a series (also indicate number of volumes in the series)
- Editor(s) of the series if the book is part of a series
- Publication city and state (or country)
- Publisher
- Date published
- Page number wherein the information is contained

Magazines and Scholarly Journals

- Author(s) of article
- Name of publication
- Volume and issue number
- Month/season and year published
- Page number wherein the information is contained

Newspapers

- Author(s) of article
- Name of publication
- City wherein the newspaper is published
- Date of publication
- Section and page number (also include column information if possible)

Encyclopedias and Dictionaries

- Name of source
- Edition
- Entry

Professional Paper or Speech

- Presenter
- Title of presentation
- Type of presentation
- Location of presentation
- Date of presentation

Manuscript Collections

- Title
- Date of the item
- Series title (if applicable)
- Name of collection
- Name of repository
- Location of document (Please be specific: MS# (if applicable), including box, folder, and item number, if available.)

Online Source (such as webpages)

- Author (if available)
- Sponsoring organization (if applicable)
- Title of webpage
- Title of website
- Date accessed
- URL
